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TASK: In-class test – 50 Minutes

Through the study of the film *The Hunger Games*, students have closely examined the definition and purpose of an allegory. For this task students are asked to demonstrate their knowledge of film techniques and how *The Hunger Games* functions as an allegory.

Students will be viewing clips from the film, and answering a variety of short and extended responses to the film.
