The task is in two (2) parts:

- (a) Issues relating to the workplace presentation
- (b) In-class extended response reflection on issues relating to the workplace (100%)

NOTE:

This is a compulsory assessment task. You are required to be in class on the above stated date to complete the task. You are to make a genuine attempt at the examination. Failing to do so may result in the awarding of the grade of 0%. If you will be away on the day, you are required to arrange an extension with your class teacher at least one (1) week in advance. If are away from school on the day of the examination due to an unplanned event, you are required to provide your teacher with a note from a parent/caregiver when you return.

Presentation (Group task)

Your group has been engaged by a local business group to produce an information presentation regarding issues in the workplace.

You must select one (1) issue from occupational health and safety, anti-discrimination and unfair dismissal, redundancy and retraining, privacy, or outsourcing.

They have requested that you prepare a presentation which they can use to assist businesses educate employees and managers to address issues in the workplace and have requested that you:

- a) Provide an overview of your selected issue;
- b) Explain how the selected issue in the workplace affects the workforce; and
- c) Outline ways to resolve the issue in the workplace.

Your presentation must include digital content. The presentation may be in the form of a short Movie, an interactive Powerpoint, or include other suitable digital media.

Reflection (Individual task)

In class on the first available Commerce period on or after 13 August 2018, you are to write an extended response reflection on the impact of issues in the workplace. You will need to address a number of different issues in the workplace with a specific focus on the issue addressed in your group presentation.

You must address:

- How do issues in the workplace affect the workforce;
- What avenues exist to provide assistance to those affected by issues in the workplace; and
- The importance of workplace education on issues affecting the workplace.
