# You will be examined on the following units in your Yearly Exam.

## Resource Management

- Fundamentals concepts of resource management - wellbeing, needs/wants, Maslow's hierarchy, resources
- Influences on resource management – Factors, access, management skills
- Personal management skills e.g. planning & organisation, communication, decision making, problem solving
- Effective resource management - strategies
- Research method – interviews

## Individuals and Groups

- Groups in the community – types, reasons, reason for formation
- Roles individuals adopt within groups – specific roles, norms, conformity & cohesiveness factors that contribute to roles (personal, social), observation
- Power within groups – power bases, leadership, factors influencing leadership
- Conflict within groups – case studies, causes, resolution

## Families and communities

- Family, structures, roles within families
- Communities – definition & reasons for formation, questionnaires, levels of community, roles within communities, decision making in communities
- Managing change in families and communities – nature of change, impact of change, types of support
- Socialisation of individuals within families and communities – stages of life span, lit review, influences on socialisation
