Create a Warrumbungles Tourism Advertisement

Create a poster that advertises the landscape and many landforms of the Warrumbungles. You should use your fieldwork and experiences on the Warrumbungles excursion to highlight your knowledge.

Make your poster appealing for people who might want to visit the national park, and include all of the exciting things they can learn about when they go there.

To complete this task you must:

- Present your poster on the cardboard provided with typed information boxes. Use subheadings to organise your boxes!
- Place a printed or hand-drawn image of the Warrumbungles in the middle of your poster
- Include a bibliography of any research
- Arrange the information boxes around your Warrumbungles picture. You must present a minimum of six topics from the below choices:

Erosion	Volcanic activity
Aboriginal land management	Aesthetic, cultural and spiritual value
Deposition	Split Rock
Mt Exmouth	Breadknife
Gorges	Protecting the landscape
Plains	Contours
Vegetation	Dominant rock types

Tips:
