## **Assessment Task: Brochure “Managing your money: the banks’ best deals’.**

In the brochure define the following products:

- (a) Savings Accounts
- (b) Cash Management Accounts
- (c) Term Deposits
- (d) Debit Cards
- (e) Credit Cards
- (f) Personal Loans

For each of these products, include in your brochure the details of the five financial institutions that have the best deals and what their rates and costs are.
