You will be assessed on how well you:

- demonstrate understanding of the poet and his context
- demonstrate an ability to analyse a poem and connect images with ideas from the poem
- demonstrate an ability to create a visual representation which combines visual and written elements
- demonstrate an ability to reflect on deliberate choices in creating the visual representation

TASK – Visual Representation (Poster)

This unit has explored the poetry of Wilfred Owen and his World War One context. You are to create a visual representation (a poster) which contains the following elements:

- a short biography of Wilfred Owen
- a summary of Owen's context and poetical influences
- an analysis of one of the poem's set for study: focus on 5-7 different stylistic features and language devices, and connect the ideas from the poem with images
- a reflection on the deliberate choices in creating the visual representation (layout, use of colour, choice of images etc)

It is expected that you will ask your teacher for feedback while you are creating your visual representation – feedback is an important step in improving your work and overall result. You will be given some class time to complete this task, however, to do well some work should be completed at home.

NOTE:

This is a compulsory assessment task. You are required to be in class on the above stated date to hand the task to your teacher. You are to make a genuine attempt at the examination.
