

Class - Year 11	Term 2 - Learning Weeks 1-2
ADVANCED ENGLISH	Module B: Shakespeare's King Lear. Each student has their own copy of King Lear. We have Google Classroom set up for correspondence and for lessons to be assigned. We will be using pre-recorded presentations as a learning tool, google docs for student work and Zoom will be used once a week for verbal discussion and reflection on work for the previous week.
STANDARD ENGLISH	Year 11 Standard English will continue their work on Module A: Contemporary Possibilities (with the documentary, Bowling for Columbine). Students will be working through google classroom, with one weekly online live lesson. Students are encouraged to be checking google classroom for regular lesson updates and to turn in their completed work for teacher feedback.
ENGLISH STUDIES	This class have been completed the work for the assessment task that is due Week 2 this term. Copies of scaffolds are on the google classroom and also in the new work booklets to be collected this week. It is expected that they will complete the tasks and continue working on the next unit which is in the booklet. There has been a google classroom set up as well for any additional resources. Students have been invited to join through their education email addresses.
MATHEMATICS/ EXT 1	Students will continue to receive lessons via google classrooms, where they will use a combination of EDROLO, text work, and worksheets.
MATHEMATICS STANDARD 2	Students will continue to receive lessons via google classrooms, where they will use a combination of EDROLO, text work, and worksheets.
MATHEMATICS STANDARD 1	Students are currently working from booklets. They have been invited to a google classroom, and need to check emails on a regular basis, to check for updates.
BIOLOGY	Module 2: Organisation of Living Things (cont.). During weeks 1 and 2 students will be learning about the structure and function of plants and digestion in mammals. Learning activities will be mainly based around the KISS notes and the Biology in Focus textbook. The learning activities for the week will be available on Google classroom each Monday. CHEMISTRY	<p>Year 11 chemistry have been issued with Chemistry in Focus for Year 11 textbooks. They have all been added to a personalised classroom on 'Google classrooms' which they are expected to logon to at least once a day and are also expected to check their student emails at least once a day. Students will be expected to virtually attend the adobe connect lessons being offered in their usual chemistry time slot. Students are currently working through Module 2 which covers areas of Science such as the Mole concept and gas laws. Year 11 will be issued with their Assessment Task 1 on the first day of Term 2 and it will be due on the Monday of Week 5, Term 2. EARTH & ENVIRONMENTAL	<p>Year 11 Earth and Environmental Science will be starting a new unit of work - Module 2: Plate Tectonics. FOOD TECHNOLOGY	Food Quality Assessment Task, Syllabus, Literacy, online resources and websites and Term 2 Scope and Sequence for Food Quality have been broken down into Google Classroom Topics. Students have Adobe Connect Online Lessons which are timetabled during their Food Technology lessons on Monday Week A Period 6 and Monday Week B Period 2. All students have hard copies of these booklets as well as a Food Technology textbook.
