Here are some of the free resources the library has on offer to support students in the lead up to their HSC exams:

HSC Collection

Macquarie Regional Library has a wide range of HSC resources, including study guides, prescribed texts and textbooks, available for loan. Members can borrow up to 10 items from the HSC Collection at a time, and it's absolutely free. The library also has a selection of HSC resources available for in-library use, perfect for study sessions!

Online Databases

The library subscribes to high quality databases that you can use to access to thousands of authoritative journals, articles and reference books on a wide range of topics. These databases make it easy to find reliable and up-to-date information, and full-text material covering virtually every subject area.

eBooks, eAudiobooks & Films

Many HSC English prescribed texts are available to download or stream in a range of formats, including annotated eBooks, unabridged eAudiobooks and films, from the library's eResource platforms.

All you need is your library card number and PIN (contact library staff to arrange for a PIN/password to be added to your card if you don't already have one).

To join, simply visit the library with proof of your name and your current address. Examples include drivers licence, rates notice, pension card, bank statement or electricity or telephone account. If you are under 18 years of age you will also need the signature of a parent or guardian.

If you are unable to visit the library, you can register for temporary eBorrower Membership online.
