### **The Task:**

You will have 45 minutes to complete a short answer and extended response in class test without notes. There will be three or four questions in this test. One question will be worth 10 to 15 marks. Questions will require students to analyse and interpret sources and apply their own knowledge.

Students will be given a practice test which they will have time to complete in class in the week leading up to the assessment. To prepare for this task students should ensure they have completed all activities in the Troy booklet and made summary notes of the readings.
