WHO CAN RECEIVE A VACCINE?

- Pfizer, for people aged:
 - 12 years and over - who are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander or have a significant underlying medical condition or disability.
 - 16 - 59 years from the general population.
- AstraZeneca is available for 18 - 59 years.
- AstraZeneca, for people aged 60 & over from the general population.
 - Exemptions for those wanting alternate vaccine will not be available at this clinic, please make an appointment with a suitable provider.

You MUST NOT attend if:

- You are waiting on a COVID-19 test result.
- You are a CONFIRMED close contact of a CONFIRMED positive COVID-19 case.
- You are unwell. If you have any COVID symptoms, get tested & isolate until you receive a negative test result.
- You have had ANY other vaccination (including flu) in the previous seven days.

You will need to bring a form of identification & where able, your medicare card
